STALLS - Kentucky Horse Park Stalls: Stalls are 10 by 10 wood plank, asphalt flooring, with full height sliding door. Front of stall and sliding door has round bars upper half.

There is a Returned Check fee of \$50.00

All entries must be postmarked by the closing date and **MUST** include

- appropriate fees, copy of USEF/USDF cards for owner, trainer, rider, if adult amateur rider must provide copy of USEF AA card. IF riding in **qualifying class**, rider and owner must be participating members of **USDF**, must also provide copies of cards and must provide copies of USEF horse recording and USDF horse registration.
- Legible copy of **Coggins**, 1 year for Kentucky & out of state horses, **Health Certificates**; within **150 days** for **KY** horses; **30 days** for horses outside Kentucky.
 - Stabling requests.
 - Signed all lines for owner, rider and trainer on entry form
 - Parent to sign for minor who rides, parent exempt from USEF fees.

NO POST ENTRIES **Awards:** Ribbons 1st thru 6th place

NO REFUND after closing date **FOR ANY REASON.**

Refund request **PRIOR** to closing date = entry fees **LESS** office fee.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Kentucky Horse Park is exit 120 off I -75 north of Lexington, KY. Go east on Iron Works Pike and enter horse park at main entrance from Iron Works Pike. Go pass Parking Booth, turn left onto Jenny Lane, turn right onto Nina Bonnie. Follow signs for EVENT STABLING. **Stalls 719 – 736 (back side of barn 7 the end facing jumping rings) will be assigned for dressage show.**
